\*To qualify for the NRA rate, you must provide evidence of NRA membership, or join the NRA at the time of orientation. Write "pending" if joining during orientation. NRA basic membership fee is currently \$10.00.

Note: It is unlawful for a person under 19 to possess or transport a handgun, except when the person is:

- (1) attending a hunter's or handgun safety course;
- (2) engaged in target shooting or in organized competition;
- (3) legally hunting or trapping;
- (4) participating in or practicing for a performance by a nonprofit organization formed under I.R.S. Code 501(c)(3);
- (5) traveling with an unloaded handgun to or from legalized activities;
- (6) on real property under the control of the under 19 person's parent, grandparent, or guardian and while under their supervision.

No person under 18 years of age may hunt with a firearm unless he carries a certificate indicating that he has successfully completed the New Mexico hunter training course.

The Los Alamos Sportsmen's Club (LASC) is an NRA-affiliated club. The LASC affiliation began in 1952. The NRA provides invaluable support to LASC in the form of training grants, range insurance, and legislative activities on state and federal levels. To retain NRA support LASC NRA membership must exceed 50%. LASC is also affiliated with the US Dept. of the Army Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP). Contact rifle section chair for CMP program details. New Mexico and federal firearms laws apply to all range users. Please consult statutes before using the ranges. Firearm and archery safety rules apply to all ranges. ABSOLUTELY no firearms are permitted on archery ranges at any time. No loaded firearms are permitted off the firing lines. The membership fee includes a \$60 work deposit. If you (or you and your family) perform 6 hours of work for the Club through the membership year, this fee will be deducted from your next year's membership renewal.

## GENERAL RANGE RULES

---

### LOS ALAMOS SPORTSMEN'S CLUB

---

- Always treat every firearm as if it were loaded.
- Never point a firearm at anything that you do not want to destroy. Keep the muzzle pointed down range at all times.
- All firearms will be unloaded and made safe before anyone goes forward of the firing line. No firearms will be handled while anyone is down range.
- Firearms may be loaded only when the shooter is on the firing line.
- Know what your target is and what is behind your target before you shoot.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target.
- Anyone on the range, whether shooter, observer, or instructor, has the authority to call for a "CEASE FIRE" if they observe an unsafe act or condition.
- Alcohol is prohibited on all firing ranges. No person will be permitted to shoot on any range if impaired by drugs or alcohol.
- Eye and ear protection is mandatory during firing.
- Live ammunition must not be discarded on the range or in the trash
- Glass and pyrotechnic targets are prohibited.
- Tracer and incendiary ammunition is prohibited.
- Event-specific rules may be adopted for LASC sanctioned events.
